His ultrabright color images are deadpan à la Hmode, but considerably smarter and more succinct than most. The most successful of these seven big pictures are frame-filling compendiums of stuff—a rack of bagged potato chips, stacks of plastic-wrapped coffee cups, shelves of laundry bags—with a cheery Pop punch that's almost Warholian. In one photo, an old woman in a laundromat nearly evaporates in a blur of motion before a row of extra-large washers (punctuated by detergent-bottle blips) that looks as monumental and decorative as a frieze.
